# N-400 Citizenship Application Checklist

Are you ready to apply for U.S. citizenship? When preparing Form N-400, Application for Naturalization, it's helpful to have the following documents on hand.

- ✓ Permanent Resident Card (green card)
- ✓ Social Security number (if you have one)
- ✓ If you traveled abroad, have the dates of each trip
- ✓ Selective Service registration information (if applicable)
- ✓ Your address information for the past 5 years
- ✓ Job and/or school information for the past 5 years
- ✓ Contact information for your current and former spouses (if applicable)
- ✓ Contact information for your children (if applicable)
